Theme and goals

"Building Texture" explores the field where live together various design approaches and techniques, coming from fashion design, architecture and contemporary art and literature. The activity of building is framed in ateliers driven by professionals of the different branch of creative design.

These labs are integrated by other teams which work with media and visual instruments – graphic and web design, photography, video making – exploiting the communication of the workshop. Meals will be designed and managed by an atelier of food design.

Target

The workshop is addressed to 100 architecture, DAMS (Disciplines of art, music and performing arts) and schools of fine arts students and newly graduates, with a penchant for teamwork and self- building, coming from Europe and Mediterranean countries.

Deadline and application form

The applicants will send their application form via email, not later then april 8th, 2009, at 6.00 pm, to the following address: info@picniclab.net. (further informations on www.picniclab.net). NOWAlab Secretary staff will send an email back to confirm the receipt of the application. Not later then April 10th, 2009 NOWAlab Secretary staff will publish on website the selected list. Together with the application the applicants will have to send the following documents, in PDF Format

(overall 3Mb max.) as an email attachment:

- applicant's curriculum (resume) with personal details, phone numbers, and email address
- authorization to release one's personal data in compliance with the Italyn Data Protection Law (D.Lgs. 196/2003)
- portfolio of completed projects, any publications or exhibitions, links to websites where to find information about the applicant
- information about two preference options among the suggested workshops.

Participation and logistics

All PIC ateliers will start simultaneously on may 5th and they will end on may 10th.

The participation fee is 230 €, work materials and assistance included.

Every participant will be able to stay in a hotel with a special rates (220 € for the whole period, one daily meal included) or to choose an independent accommodation.

The workshop will be along the Linear Park, at Arena Garden, Tempio Valley _ San Michele di Ganzaria _ Sicily.
